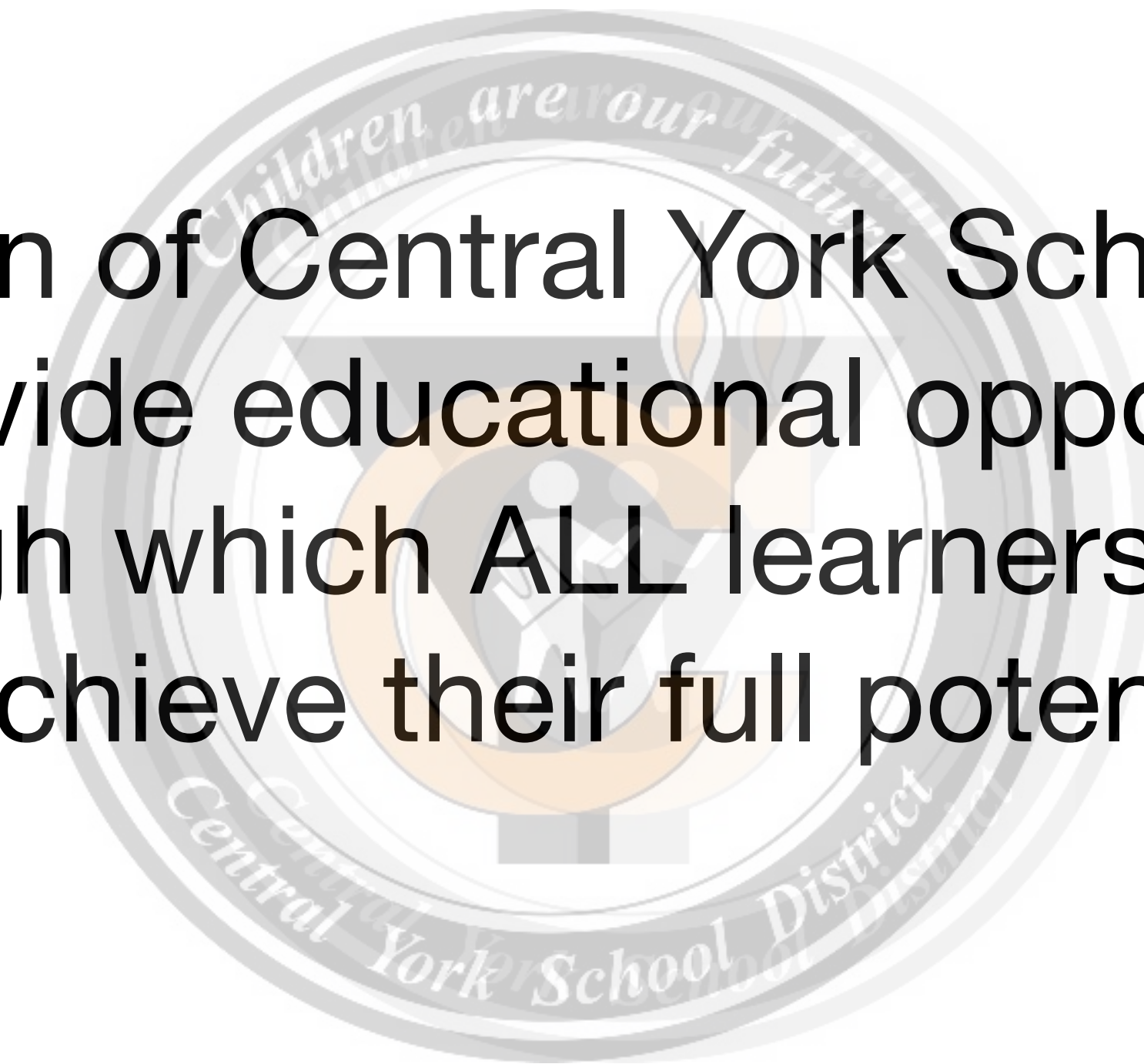

# **Four Learning Options for Fall 2020**

- **Full-time Traditional Brick & Mortar (At School)**
- **Full-time Remote Learning (At Home)**
- **CYSD Cyber Academy (Grades 3-12)**
- **Lincoln Edge Cyber School (Grades K-12)**

# **Full-time Traditional (Brick & Mortar/At School)**

- **Traditional Central York School District curriculum**
- **Transportation to and from school**
- **Social distancing**
  - 6 feet to the maximum extent feasible
  - Classrooms and other spaces
- **Face coverings required (masks, shields, cloth coverings)**
- **No visitors or volunteers initially**
- **Increased cleaning, sanitizing, disinfecting and ventilation**

# **Full-time Traditional (Brick & Mortar/At School)**

- **Food Service Plan**
  - Breakfast served in classrooms (K-12)
  - Lunch served in classroom (K-6)
  - Lunch served in cafeteria & areas outside of cafeteria (7-12)
- **Increased hygiene practices**
- **Monitoring of student and staff health**
- **Plans to support mental health and wellness**



# **Full-time Remote Learning (At Home)**

- **Traditional Central York School District Curriculum**
- **Delivered by Central York School District Teachers**
- **Students learn from home with regular instruction from Central York teachers**
  - Some assignments are self-paced/independent
  - Some learning is real-time, teacher-led instruction with classmates
- **Use of Schoology and student's school issued device**
- **Transition back to traditional brick-and-mortar learning**

# **Full-Time Cyber: Central York Cyber Academy**

- **Current Central Cyber Academy Curriculum  
(Meets PA Standards)**
- **Available for Grades 3-12**
- **Certified Teachers (Not Central York Teachers)**
- **Independent Learning at Student's Own Pace**
- **Courseware through Edgenuity/Odysseyware**
- **Qualifies for a Central York School District Diploma**

# **Full-Time Cyber: Lincoln Edge Cyber School**

- **Current Cyber School Offering Through Lincoln Intermediate Unit No. 12**
- **Available for Grades K-12**
- **Certified Teachers (Not Central York Teachers)**
- **Blend of Real-Time Instruction with Teacher and Independent Learning at Student's Own Pace**
- **Courseware through Edgenuity/Odysseyware**
- **Qualifies for a Central York School District Diploma**
